The document presented (budget 2013-2016) takes into account the exchange rate of 1,25 (EUR/CH).

Aase Marie HUNDERE underlined that RCN will take into account the budget in KEUR for 2013-2016. For SER and RCN the planned contributions are in KEUR 2013 : 740, 2014: 760, 2015: 780, 2016: 800 for each party.

It was underlined that:

- Any additional amount will no longer be part of the CONTRACT.
- Contributions outside contract can either come from both countries on the terms and conditions agreed by both, or it may come from one country only without binding the other partner.
- The financial plan (annual expenditure budgets and annual income budgets) will be approved in EUR for the 4-year period 2013-2016.
- Reserves are to be organized from savings accumulated, via exchange rate from 2013: "E.R.R," (Exchange Rate RESERVES).
- It will be for SNX Council to solve the problem if exchange rate becomes disadvantageous.
- It is suggested to have a yearly discussion on the exchange rate fixed each year regarding CHF/EUR and NOK/EUR. Each party shall contribute with the same amount.

Martin STEINACHER thanked Aase Marie HUNDERE for the effort of the RCN to match the proposed annual contributions 2013-2016 by SER.
