WHAT IS THE RUN OF SHOW PAGE

Forj's Run of Show page is an integrated way for all hosts, moderators and presenters to open or join their sessions. As a presenter or moderator, the join links displayed to you on this page are your unique session links to join as a panelist. You may access this at any time in the event, but the session will only open and permit you inside once the host has opened up the room. This is generally done 30 minutes prior to the session start time to allow for green room time where you can review and prepare for the session.


The Run of Show page can be accessed from the main event navigation:

Once in the Run of Show page, you will see all sessions in the event listed like the image below. If you are a presenter in the event, you will only see the sessions in which you are presenting. This will be the same for any moderators as well.

Simply click the Start Session button to join the session as a panelist or moderator. You may only be put in the room if a host has already opened the room up. If not, you will just see a window letting you know it's waiting for the host to open – you may leave this open and will be entered in once the host opens it up for the green room time.

If you're already logged into Zoom using another account you can switch accounts by clicking the "switch account" link on the next screen.

Make sure to click **Open Zoom Meeting**. You will then be in the Zoom webinar or meeting room as a panelist.

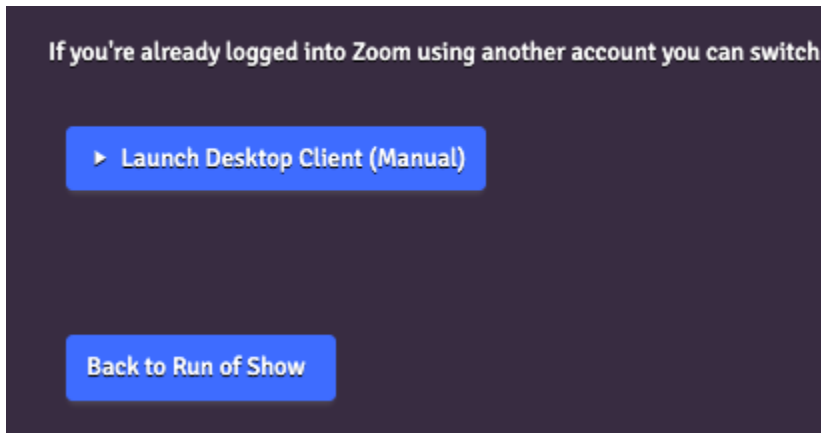

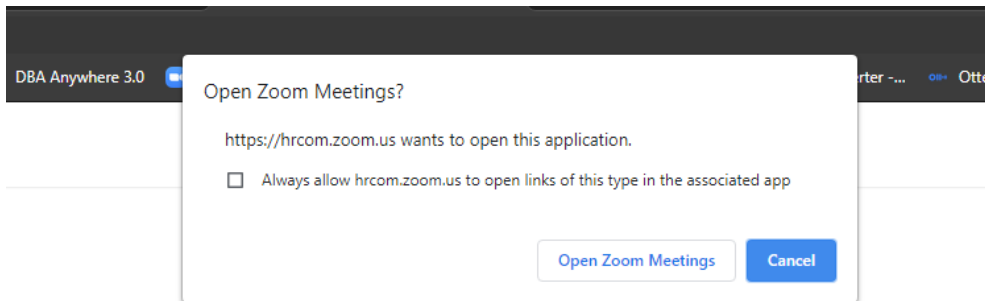
Launch with Manual Sign On

Once done, the host will end the session and you will be right back on the same page as when you joined the session. To get back to the main list, simply click the bottom Back to Run of Show button.

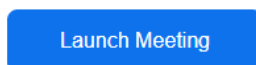
